About Bhaskara Foundation

Bhaskara Foundation is a committed not-for-profit organization working towards sustainable development through skill-based livelihood training and employment generation. We believe in empowering underserved youth with industry-relevant skills that lead to long-term career opportunities and improved quality of life.

Key Programs and Activities (FY 2023–24)

1. Women Empowerment Training in Tailoring

In collaboration with various stakeholders and local partners, Bhaskara Foundation implemented **women-centric skill development programs in tailoring** across five states. These trainings were focused on enabling women to become self-reliant through stitching, garment-making, and micro-enterprise development.

- **Locations Covered:**
 - **Berhampur (Odisha)**
 - **Bhopal (Madhya Pradesh)**
 - **Davanagere (Karnataka)**
 - **Ichalkaranji (Maharashtra)**
 - **Ratlam (Madhya Pradesh)**
- **Total Women Trained:** 750
- **Livelihood Enhancement Achieved:** Over 85% of trained women have either started their own tailoring businesses, taken job-work contracts, or joined local production units.
- **Support Provided:** Toolkits, business mentoring, market linkage facilitation, and digital payment literacy.

2. Skill Development Training – General Duty Assistant (GDA) & Self-Employed Tailor

In the districts of **Thiruvannamalai and Vellore (Tamil Nadu)**, Bhaskara Foundation implemented placement-linked skill development programs under the NSQF framework, focusing on the following job roles:

- **General Duty Assistant (GDA):** Training focused on caregiving, clinical hygiene, and patient assistance in healthcare settings.
- **Self-Employed Tailor:** Training emphasized garment construction, customer service, and home-based entrepreneurship.
- **Total Beneficiaries Trained:** 180
- **Overall Placement Rate:** Over 82% of the trained candidates have been placed in hospitals, clinics, tailoring shops, or have become self-employed through home-based enterprises.

Program Impact Highlights

- **Empowered over 930 individuals across 7 districts in 5 states.**
- **Women's economic participation increased substantially**, especially in tailoring and micro-entrepreneurship.
- **High placement and livelihood success rates (80%+)** in both self-employment and wage employment.
- Enhanced digital literacy, financial inclusion, and access to government welfare schemes for all participants.

Looking Ahead

Bhaskara Foundation aims to expand its training outreach, integrate advanced and market-relevant skills into the curriculum, and build stronger industry linkages for improved placement outcomes. We remain committed to uplifting underserved communities through quality skill development and inclusive livelihood strategies.

Her husband works in sales, with a monthly salary of Rs. 10,000/-. His earning is not enough to meet the expenses of the family.

Determined to support her family, Manjula decided to acquire new skills. She enrolled in tailoring course at Bhaskara Skill center at Davanagere. Manjula became a master at balancing her household chores, childcare responsibilities, and her newfound passion for tailoring. She worked tirelessly to hone her skills. After completion of her training, she started working at Spandana's Garment Manufacturing Unit with a monthly remuneration of Rs.3600 to support her family.
